

HOW CAN I DELIVER MY CONTENT TO ERIC?

Are you a publisher under agreement with ERIC wondering about the best way to provide us your content? Below we outline the different ways we accept PDFs and XML for indexing.

CONTENT DELIVERY OPTIONS



SITE DOWNLOAD - OUR PREFERRED METHOD

The ERIC team visits publisher websites to download new content. We visit publisher websites based on the frequency of publication.



Benefits to you:

- You do not have to send ERIC any content. The ERIC team will collect everything on your behalf.



Requirements:

- You must have open-access content or give ERIC a username and password for access to the site.
- To get content into ERIC faster, include ERIC@ed.gov on any email notifications about new articles and publications. ERIC will enter your content promptly.



ERIC SFTP SITE

Publisher loads content onto ERIC's SFTP site. Zipped files are preferred.



Benefits to you:

- Secure environment for you to transfer your content to ERIC.
- You can post large volumes of content as needed.
- Easy to combine PDF and XML in the same upload.
- You can automate the process to send new content.



Requirement:

- ERIC will set up an account and send you the secure site address, a username, and a password.



EMAIL

Publisher emails content to ERIC@ed.gov.



Benefits to you:

- You can easily and selectively submit content.
- ERIC will enter the content promptly and let you know if there are any questions.



Requirement:

- Schedule your content for timely delivery to ERIC.



PUBLISHER FTP SITE

The ERIC team downloads content from the publisher's FTP site.



Benefits to you:

- PDFs and XML can be combined in the same load.
- ERIC visits FTP sites multiple times a year, when a notification is received at ERIC@ed.gov, or based on publication frequency if known.



Requirement:

- You must give ERIC a username and password for access to the site.
