- *Academics* including professors, students, and librarians look for peer-reviewed materials to inform research, increase knowledge, and support patrons.

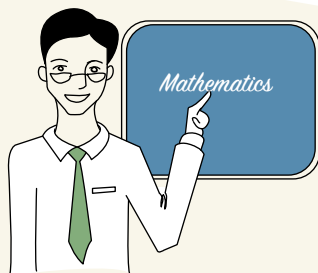


- *Researchers* frequently seek the latest evidence-based articles for their work, and also contribute their finished research to **ERIC**.



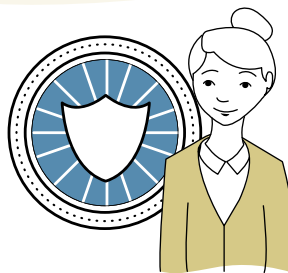
RESEARCHERS
