

ERIC Collection Snapshot

ERIC is a bibliographic and full-text digital library of education research. ERIC was founded in 1964 and includes content from 1907 – present. As of January 1, 2021, the collection encompasses the following:

- 1,070 publishers participating from 41 countries
- 1,248 journals and 727 non-journal sources (actively indexed)
- 1,827,824 total records; 48,000 added annually
- 1,034,253 records of peer-reviewed content; 438,381 records with full text



Sources in ERIC cover the full spectrum of subjects in education divided into 16 topic areas. Topic area names are based on the IES authorizing legislation and originate from ERIC's previous network of 16 subject-specific clearinghouses. The wheel below displays the percentage of actively indexed journals and non-journal sources for each topic area within the collection. Click the topic area name to see the sources in that category.





ERIC sources bring high-quality content to the collection. Below are the numbers of journals and non-journal sources that provide peer-reviewed and full-text content to ERIC:

- 465 Peer reviewed and full text
- 862 Peer reviewed and no full text
- 500 Not peer reviewed and full text
- 148 Not peer reviewed and no full text
