

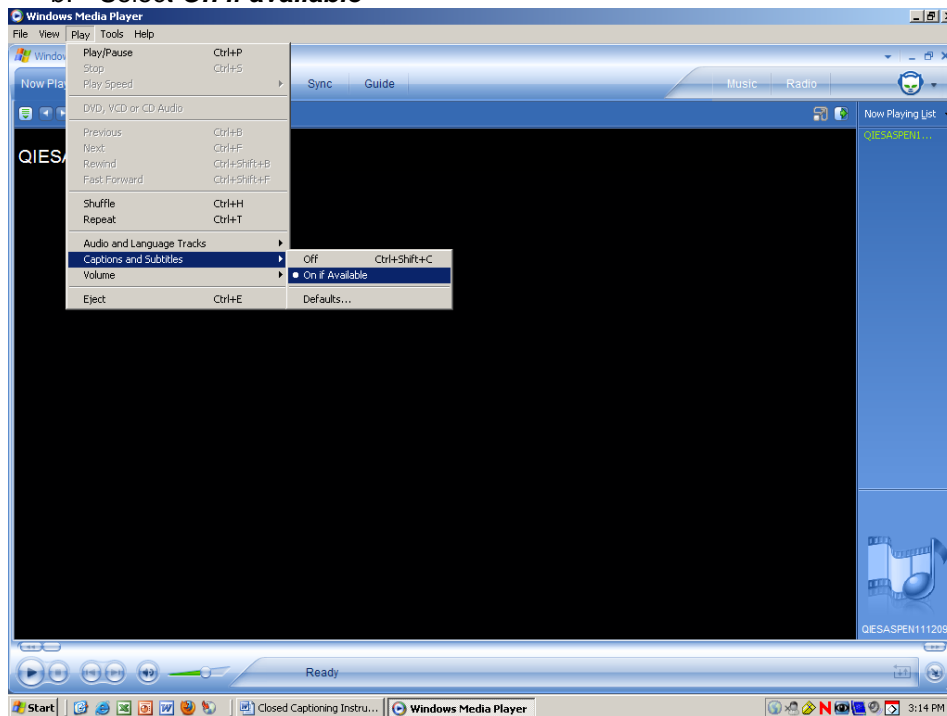
Playing a Windows Media File with Closed Captioning

If you do not have a Windows Media player available on your computer, you will need to have a player installed prior to viewing a Windows Media file.

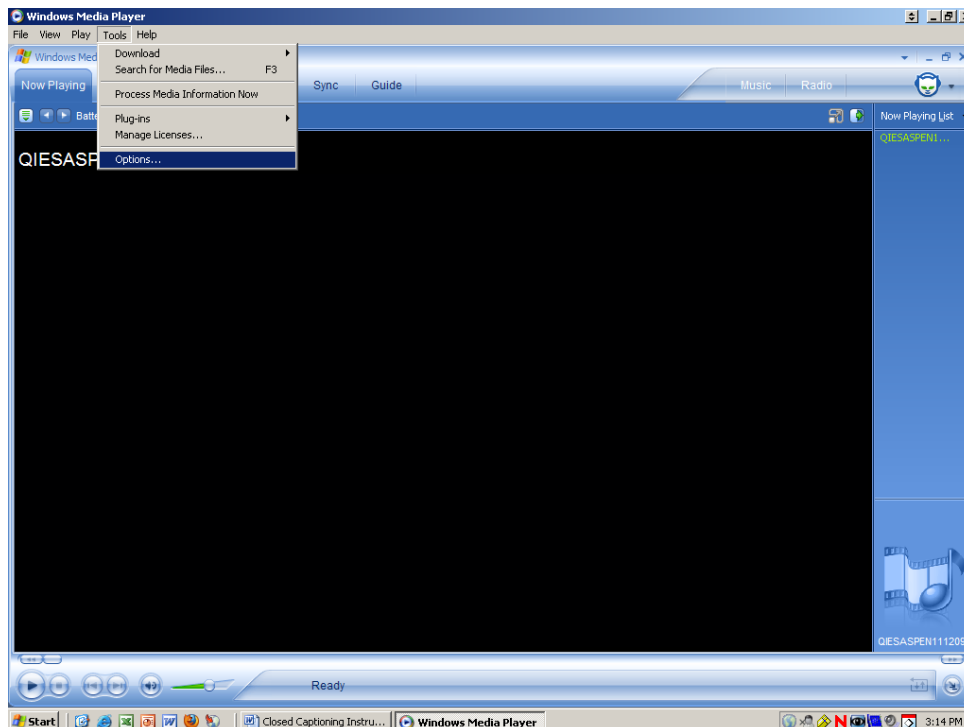
Windows Media Player may be downloaded from Microsoft at:

Activating Closed Captioning in the Windows Media Player:

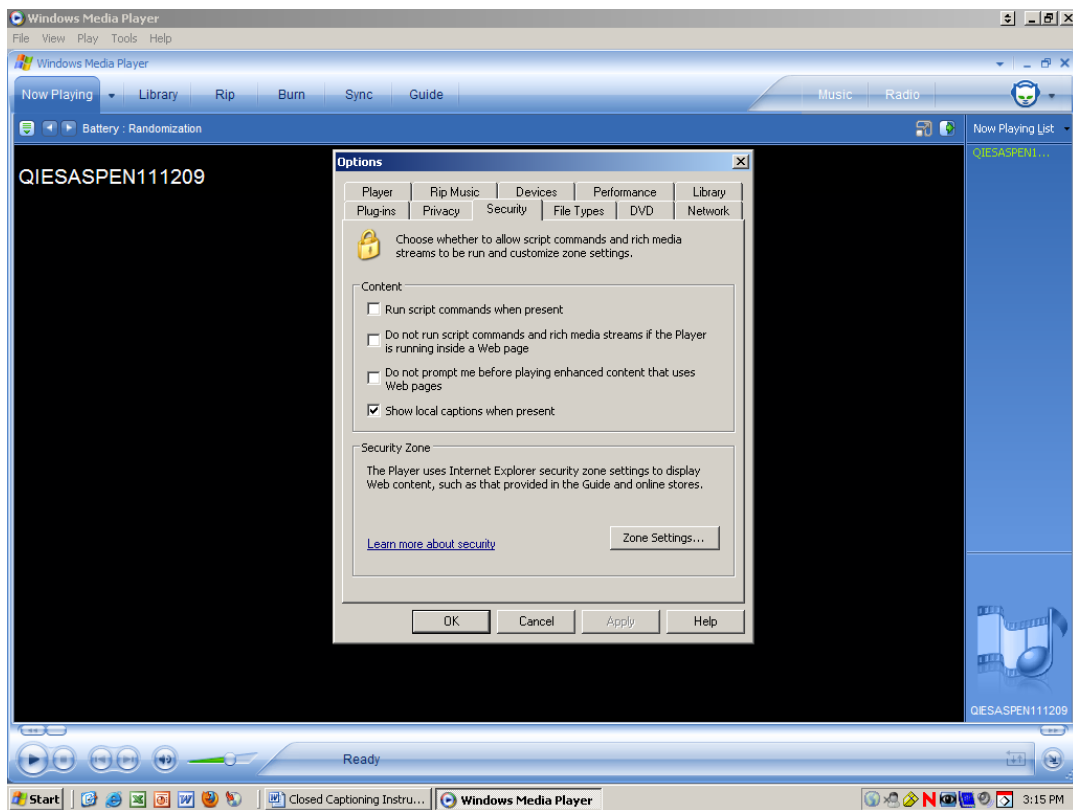
1. Open the Windows Media Player
2. Select **Play** from the menu at the top of the screen
 - a. Select **Captions and Subtitles**
 - b. Select **On if available**



3. Select **Tools** from the menu at the top of the screen
 - a. Select **Options**



- b. Select the **Security** tab
- c. Make sure **Show Local Captions When Present** is selected
- d. Click **Apply** and **OK**



4. Close the Windows Media Player and re-access recording
