iQIES for IRFs is Now Available

On June 3, 2019, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) sent an email to Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility Providers (IRFs) indicating that in coming months, all IRF users will be required to access the new assessment submission and reporting system known as the Internet Quality Improvement and Evaluation System (iQIES) to submit patient assessments and view reports.

As of October 1, 2019, the Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility Patient Assessment Instrument (IRF-PAI) submission functionality within the Quality Improvement and Evaluation System (QIES) Assessment Submission and Processing (ASAP) system is no longer available and users are required to access iQIES to submit patient assessments and view associated reports.

Please note that failure to obtain access to iQIES will impact your ability to submit assessment data needed for claims matching purposes.

In order to access iQIES, users must create an account and establish login credentials in the Healthcare Quality Information System (HCQIS) Access Roles and Profile system (HARP).
