I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: The Model Participant Provider M1 screen, is an MCS screen used to look up providers who are participating in the Emergency, Triage, and Transport (ET3) model or the Value in Opioid Use Disorder Treatment (VIT) program. The Model Participant Provider Report (H99RVMPP) captures ET3 and VIT participant provider adds, changes, and deletes identified from the processing of the weekly participant providers file job WV65.

The M1 screen currently does not include a data creation date indicating when the record was created. When an update is received, the Update Date (UPDT DT) field is updated but the user cannot see when the prior record was created.

The H99RVMPP report currently does not include a column indicating which MAC locality the data is specific to. The information that posts on this report is from a national file so it includes all MAC data. Therefore, the MACs do not know which records on this report apply to their jurisdiction.

Therefore, the purpose of this CR is to update the M1 screen in MCS to display the date a record is created when a new provider record is added to the file or when an existing record is replaced due to a change to the file. The H99RVMPP report is also being updated to specify which Medicare Administrative Contractor (MAC) the data pertains to.
