Background: The purpose of this CR is to direct the MACs to gain access to CMS Jira and Confluence tools, and to modify their internal workflow to ensure all MAC staff that need access to information currently stored in Infoman/VIC also have access to these two applications. In an effort to modernize the development of system changes, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has directed the Shared System Maintainers (SSMs) to use a hybrid Agile development methodology to implement CRs in each quarterly release. As a part of this effort, the SSMs are now using Jira and Confluence as tools to create and track system requirements and test plans for CRs. This information is also stored in the tool Infoman/VIC.
