I. GENERAL INFORMATION

- **A. Background:** This change request is an instruction to the MACs to upload into the STAR system the cost reports rate reviews and settlement packages. The information would be made available for download in the Medicare Cost Report e-Filing system (MCReF) to Medicare Part A providers. At this time, the instruction for the MACs to upload these review packages into the STAR system is not meant to replace the current process of mailing the documentation to the providers.
- **B.** Policy: Medicare Part A providers are required to file Medicare cost reports with the MACs yearly. The MACs perform tentative settlements on the as-filed cost report, and the cost report is used to set interim rates for the providers. The as-filed cost reports are either reviewed or audited before by the MACs issue the final cost report settlement.
