SUBJECT: User Enhancement Change Request (UECR): Fiscal Intermediary Shared System (FISS) - Expand Ability to Search Through the Revenue Lines and Apply User Defined Quantity Limits to One or More Services - Full Agile Pilot

I. SUMMARY OF CHANGES: The purpose of this UECR is to enhance the Medicare Administrative Contractor's (MACs) ability to compare one or more outpatient services, provided on the same service date, to determine which lines should be paid and/or denied.

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I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: The MACs use ECPS to create events that automate manual functions. The use of ECPS reduces overall program costs by allowing resources to focus on claims where no automated solution is available.

ECPS has limited capabilities to compare one of more outpatient claim lines, with the same service date, to determine whether to pay or deny one or more lines. The MAC originally requested this UECR as an enhancement to ECPS. After thorough investigation, FISS determined that implementing in ECPS was far too complex for the system's current capabilities. FISS suggested a new core function that allows the MACs to define quantity limits for specific services and set reason codes in FISS that would drive claims to ECPS when the limits are exceeded. The combined functionality of the new screen and the existing functionality to design and implement ECPS events will accomplish most what the UECR requested.

CMS and FISS agreed that additional enhancements to the minimally viable product may be added in future releases.

B. Policy: This UECR is an enhancement to MAC system tools. There are no policy implications.
