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I. SUMMARY OF CHANGES: The purpose of this Change Request (CR) is to update the functionality of the User File Copy Request screen to allow file maintenance importing across processing regions for a Medicare Administrative Contractor (MAC) maintaining multiple MAC jurisdictions.

#### II. GENERAL INFORMATION

**A.** Background: The purpose of this Change Request (CR) is to update the functionality of the User File Copy Request screen to allow file maintenance importing across processing regions for a MAC maintaining multiple MAC jurisdictions.

Currently, a MAC cannot import files from one MAC jurisdiction to another. The functionality is limited to file imports within a Customer Information Control System (CICS) region, different MCS plan codes same MAC. This requires the MAC to perform duplicate file maintenance and testing if they maintain multiple contracts. Allowing the MAC to perform maintenance in one CICS region and import that maintenance to another jurisdiction will reduce efforts by eliminating duplicate file maintenance and testing between jurisdictions.

It is not the intent of this change to allow a MAC to import files outside of their existing contracts/jurisdictions. This control logic currently is in place and shall remain.

**Example:** Jurisdiction H shall not be permitted to import a file to Jurisdiction E. Jurisdiction H shall be permitted to import a file to Jurisdiction L or vice versa.

The MAC jurisdictions this change applies to are as follows:

#### Jurisdiction J and M

J- for the states of Alabama, Georgia and Tennessee, plan code 16, CICS region J1.

M- for the states of North Carolina, plan code 31, CICS region B3; South Carolina, plan code 83, CICS region B1; Virginia, plan code 90, CICS region B2, West Virginia, plan code 36, CICS region B4.

#### Jurisdiction H and L
