- 12 Early Adoption Users trained so far with 4 or so left to train.
- Most have been able to test in some capacity and report findings back.
- The feedback has been helpful for the Development team to continue improving the functionality.

iQIES Offline FAQ

- **Q:** How does log in work?
- **A:** The same as when you are online, you will use the same username and password as you do in the live system... when you navigate to iQIES when offline the system will recognize you. You just will not be presented with the 2 Factor Authentication.

- **Q:** Does the 15 minute timeout happen offline?
- **A:** Yes, the timeout is still a requirement for iQIES Offline.

What will be available?

- Provider Details – viewable with multiple data elements editable.
- Survey - most viewable with major areas like citations, forms and notes editable.
- Intakes - Viewable with edit ability of allegations, notes and investigation narrative.
- Enforcements – View Only.
