Dear Director Stolfi:

On July 13, 2022, the Department of Health and Human Services and the Department of the Treasury approved Oregon's application for an extension of its State Innovation Waiver under Section 1332 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA). Oregon's approved extension application waives the ACA's requirement for the single risk pool to the extent necessary to implement a state reinsurance program called the Oregon Reinsurance Program for plan years 2023 through 2027.

It is the Department of the Treasury's final administrative determination that Oregon's pass-through funding amount for calendar year 2024 is \$68,269,450, which must be used for purposes of implementing Oregon's State Innovation Waiver. This amount reflects Oregon's mid-year implementation of a Basic Health Program.
