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## I. GENERAL INFORMATION

**A. Background:** The Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) utilize the FISS Lump Sum Utility tool in their current activities for recording and performing outlier reconciliation. This tool produces an extract that calculates the difference between the original Prospective Payment Systems (PPS) payment amounts and revised PPS payment amounts into a Microsoft Access generated report, based on differences in the hospital's original and revised capital and/or operating cost-to-charge ratios. The Lump Sum Utility calculates the original and revised payments offline, with no effect to the original claim payment amounts as displayed in various CMS systems.

This change request enhances the functionality of the tool by adding wage index fields to the utility. These new wage index fields shall not be used as part of the outlier reconciliation process. The new fields shall be used to create an extract file to calculate the difference in PPS payment amounts based on revised wage index values. When directed by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), the MACs shall use this functionality for calculating adjusted reimbursement outside of the claim payment for providers whose wage index data was changed during a specific cost reporting period.
