I. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: The 'Other Amounts Indicator' is a single position alpha-numeric field and has limited number of values remaining. CMS is requesting that the impacted systems expand the 'Other Amounts Indicator' to two (2) positions alpha-numeric to allow the systems to carry additional values in the future.

The 'Other Amounts Indicator' field is used to indicate the type/model the reimbursement to be applied based on the allowed amounts. Common Working File (CWF) has edits in place to validate the 'Other Amounts Indicator' and to ensure the reimbursement amounts are correct based on the Other Amounts carried in the detail line(s). CWF also stores the 'Other Amounts Indicator' in History and sends values to National Claims History (NCH).
