

# 300 Chinese Nationals Being Surveilled for Coronavirus

Liberian health authorities claim they are surveilling and tracking 300 Chinese and 11 Liberians that recently returned to Liberia from China, amid the outbreak of the coronavirus in China, a senator told parliament Thursday. "We are tracing all these people. We have information from the Liberian Immigration Service. These people will be quarantined for 10 to 12 days," Dr. Peter Coleman, chairman on Health in Liberia's upper house of parliament told colleagues on Thursday. He did not say where they would be quarantined. A senior immigration officer who declined to be name told TNR that "we have records on them. Where they went. Remember we have their contact details and is easy to track them down." Senator Coleman said, it is important for Liberians to be on alert and not to be taken by surprise in anyway. "We want to be on the alert and not to be caught pants down," he said.
