## The *All of Us*Research Program

All of Us is a new research program. The goal is to learn how differences between us might lead to different types of treatments.

We want **one million or more people** to join. People who join will share their information. This might be about their health, habits, and what it's like where they live. It might also be about family history and genes.

Researchers will use this to do studies. This may help improve health for everyone.

### WHAT KIND OF INFORMATION WILL PARTICIPANTS GIVE?

Participants will be asked to:



Take online surveys



Share their electronic health record (EHR)

Participants may be asked to:



Give blood and urine samples



Have their physical measurements taken







- 1. Participation is free.
- **2.** Participants do not need to change providers to join.
- **3.** Enrollment will not interfere with the way participants receive care from their current health care team.
- **4.** Participants will be asked to complete online surveys about their health history, lifestyle habits, and environment.
- **5.** Participants will be asked to provide access to their electronic health records.
- **6.** Participants may be asked to visit a partner site to have basic physical measurements taken and to provide blood and urine samples.
- 7. The program has rigorous safeguards in place to protect data security and participant privacy.
- **8.** The program may last for 10 years or more.
- **9.** Participants may withdraw at any time.
- **10.** Participants will have access to their own data and summarized results from across the program.
