Purpose

- To enhance collaborative, multi-disciplinary basic and clinical research by integrating an information specialist into the research team in order to improve the capture, storage, organization, management, integration, presentation and dissemination of biomedical research data
- To assess and document the value and impact of the informationist's participation on the project and as member of the research team – this should be one of the specific aims of the project

Dates and Budget

Application Deadline -- July 17, 2015

Est. Start Date – October 2015

\$25,000 per year up to 2 years

Normal host project indirect costs

Administrative Supplement Mechanism

- Supplemental award made to existing grants (must be active for the entire supplement period)
- Submitted by PI of existing research grant
- 14 Institutes and a Center Participating
- All R01s, R21s and listed grant codes for individual Institutes

Administrative Supplement Mechanism

- Funds can be used to cover cost increases that are associated with achieving certain new research objectives, as long as the research objectives are within the original scope of the approved project, or the cost increases are for unanticipated expenses within the original scope of the project. The goal is to increase or preserve the overall impact of the project consistent with its originally approved objectives and purposes.

Administrative Supplement Mechanism

5 page research strategy section

One application per research project

Can have multiple projects from an institution

Letter of support/commitment from Dir of Health Sciences Library Strongly encouraged

Statement of commitment from the Informationist

Administrative Supplement Mechanism

- Confirmed funding for 5 awards.
- In past years we received co-funding from the participating ICs to fund 8 in 2012 and 11 in 2014.
- This year we are hopeful to also secure co-funding so we can fund many more than 5.
