## Frequently Asked Question for SM-18-004

## Question:

The FOA indicates that an allowable activity is "on-site primary care that is equipped to diagnose and treat HIV and hepatitis". However, a Funding Restriction indicates that "funds may not be used for providing HIV or hepatitis primary care services. However, costs related to HIV or hepatitis testing, pre and post-counseling, and confirmatory testing may be included in your budget". Can you please clarify this apparent discrepancy?

## Answer

Funds cannot be used for any primary care activities other than costs related to HIV or hepatitis testing, pre- and post-counseling, and confirmatory testing. All other costs for primary care services are unallowable.
