Interesting Facts from SSA's National Beneficiary Survey (NBS)

How many hours do beneficiaries work and what are their wages? How does work activity vary by participation in Ticket to Work (TTW)?*

- Beneficiaries participating in TTW (either with an Employment Network (EN) or State Vocational Rehabilitation Agency
 (SVRA)) were substantially more likely to be working than those who were not participating (28% of those who assigned
 their tickets to an EN and 23% of those who assigned to an SVRA were employed, compared to 7% of those who were not
 participating).
- Employed beneficiaries who assigned their ticket to an EN had higher wages and higher monthly pay at their current main
 job than employed beneficiaries who were not participating in TTW (\$10.31 and \$893.81 compared to \$8.08 and \$692.74,
 respectively).
- Almost half (46%) of working beneficiaries with tickets assigned to an SVRA were working in a sheltered workshop compared to 39% of beneficiaries who were not participating in TTW. Beneficiaries with tickets assigned to an EN were less likely to be working in a sheltered workshop (32%).
- While ENs and SVRAs both serve TTW participants, they follow different rules for enrollment. ENs are able to choose who
 they serve, while SVRAs are mandated to prioritize services to beneficiaries with the most severe disabilities. Better outcomes for EN clients may therefore be due, in part, to these differences in TTW enrollment rules.
